I write on behalf of the board and constituents of Just Communities of Arkansas to respectfully request that all consideration be given to creating a majority/minority Hispanic district in Northwest Arkansas during the current redistricting process.

We understand fully how difficult it will be to re-draw boundaries taking all competing interests into consideration. However, our request is based on several factors:

- The 114% population growth in the region's Hispanic community.
- The likelihood that this community will continue to grow in percentage of eligible voters—at present there are 16,000 linguistically diverse students in the area schools.
- The reality that the Hispanic population (along with the Marshallese) are increasingly engaging in the civic life of our state, and recognition of them as a Community of Interest during the redistricting process would further motivate them to be involved and inhibit fracturing within their community.
- The importance of recognition of the continuing Hispanic contributions to Arkansas.
- The fact that to date there has been no member of the Hispanic community elected to a state office.

Whether or not formation of the majority/minority district would result in election of a person of Hispanic descent to our legislature is yet to be seen. But if such a district is created, whoever is elected would be accountable to that specific community.

We thank you for your service to our state and your consideration of this request.


